

REQUIRED PACKING LIST

Clothing

- 12 T-shirts make 2 blue/2 gold
- 10 Shorts (any color)
 - 2 Sweatshirts
 - 4 Sweatpants, jeans
- 12 Underpants
- 14 Pair of socks
- 4 Sleepwear (including boxer shorts)
- 4 Swimsuits
- 1 Light weight jacket
- 1 *Hooded raincoat, poncho or waterproof jacket*
- 2 Baseball caps

Bedding/Linens and Packing

- 2 Blankets and 1 sleeping bag
(Or comforter and sleeping bag)
or 2 blankets)
- 4 Cot sized sheets (72x30)
(2 flat and 2 fitted)
- Pillow case sets
 - 1 Pillow
- 10 Towels
 - 1 Laundry bag
 - 1 Duffel bag, canvas or nylon
 - 1 Soft trunk preferred
- 1 Pair flip-flops
- 2 Pair of Sneakers

Toiletry Articles

- 2 Toothbrushes, Shampoo (with tea tree)
- Comb or Brush, Drinking cup, Toothpaste,
Toothbrush, Soap & dish, Tooth brush holder,
Shower caddy, **Sun screen**, nail clipper

Sports Equipment (For boys and girls)

- Soccer shinguards, baseball glove,
Shatterproof athletic glasses, Hockey helmet
with cage (girls completed 1st-4th grades
not required)

Optional

- All purpose soccer cleats, tennis racket and
balls, sports mouthpiece, hockey gloves,
swim goggles, lacrosse stick, hockey
stick, fishing rod (with barbless hooks only),
Roller-Blading protective equipment 2
(Elbow pads, helmet, wrist guards)

Other Suggested Items

- Extra batteries for games and music, pens,
pencils, stationary, camera, flashlight,
books, and extra pair of glasses
masquerade costume for campers who have
just completed grades 1-4. Cabaret clothing.

Pre-addressed and stamped envelopes are recommended for younger campers.

LAUNDRY

* Laundry is done once a week, on the camp premises. Campers, therefore, need enough clothing for 10 days. The added days are in cases of spills and such. Name Tapes should be used on all clothing (including clothes worn on the bus). Use adhesive tape and indelible ink on shoes, toilet articles, tennis rackets, camera, game boys, etal. We have found that many laundry markers are inadequate as they will fade on clothing washed weekly. Items and clothing with names are easily returned if lost or forgotten.

* Laundry is a simple camp chore that helps develop responsibility. Campers will be responsible to sort their dirty clothes and place them in the cabin laundry bags. The bags are then picked up, washed by our laundry staff and returned to the cabin.
