## CLOTHING

- 12 T-Shirts  
(Include some Blue and Yellow for Color War)
- 12 Shorts (Any color)
- 2 Sweatshirts
- 2 Long Pants (Sweats or Jeans)
- 12 Underpants
- 14 Pairs of Socks
- 6 Sleepwear
- 6 Swimsuits
- 1 hooded raincoat or poncho
- 2 Baseball hats

## BEDDING/LINENS AND PACKING

- 1 Blanket/Comforter and Sleeping Bag
- 4 Twin size sheets (2 fitted and 2 flat)
- 2 Pillow cases

- 1 Laundry bag
- 2 soft trunks or duffel bags

## FOOTWEAR

- 2 Pairs of sneakers
- 1 Pair of flip flops or sandals

## TOILETRIES

- 2 Toothbrushes
